Real estate is essential to New Mexico's Economic Health

The real estate industry accounted for **\$17.1 billion** or **15.7%** of the gross product of New Mexico in 2021.

# MULTIPLIER OF RELATED EXPENSES

Revenue generated from a home sale in one sector of the economy is reinvested into other areas such as **grocery stores**, hair salon, house cleaning, yard maintenance, auto repair, etc.

# NEW HOME CONSTRUCTION

Additional home sales induce added home production. Typically, one new home is constructed for every six existing home sales. Thus, for every existing home sale, 1/6 of a new home's value is added to the economy.
